



Quint Studer appears on “Conversations with Jeff Weeks”

Pensacola, FL, August 26, 2014—On air this week, WSRE’s “Conversations with Jeff Weeks” welcomes entrepreneur and community leader Quint Studer. The program will air Thursday at 7:30 p.m., Friday at 12:30 a.m. and Sunday at 11 a.m. on WSRE, PBS for the Gulf Coast.

“Quint Studer has made a measurable impact on this community,” said host Jeff Weeks, “from professional sports to education to retail and real estate development. Studer and his wife Rishy have committed to giving a million dollars in scholarships and have pumped millions into downtown redevelopment, and there is more to come.”

During the interview with Weeks, Studer discusses his new ventures, including the Studer Institute, and his desire to help make Pensacola a thriving city. Studer provides insight into his long range plans and why he is investing so much of his own money and time into the city he now calls home.

The Studers recently purchased the Pensacola News Journal site with plans for residential and commercial development. In early 2014, they formed the Studer Institute, an organization whose goal is to improve the quality of life in local communities.

As founder of Studer Group, Inc., Studer has helped improve working conditions, physician relations and patient care for healthcare organizations in the United States and abroad, and he has authored a number of books on leadership, how to be a great employee and patient care.

Studer first appeared on “Conversations with Jeff Weeks” in 2011 when he and his wife had recently purchased the Carolina Mudcats Double-A baseball team to move the team to Pensacola; today they are owners of the Cincinnati Reds Double-A affiliate Pensacola Blue Wahoos.

“Conversations with Jeff Weeks” is a personality-driven half-hour program featuring in-depth discussions with unique individuals and leading newsmakers from all walks of life.
