

## Tickets are now on sale for Ethan Bortnick: Live in Concert at WSRE Young entertainer invites Pensacola Children's Chorus to share the stage

Pensacola, FL, September 3, 2014—Ticket sales for the upcoming Ethan Bortnick concert at WSRE are now open to the general public, and tickets may go fast with the announcement that the Pensacola Children's Chorus will be performing with the young entertainer. WSRE will host Ethan Bortnick Live in Concert at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, October 28 in the Jean & Paul Amos Performance Studio.

In addition to the Pensacola Children's Chorus, Damian McGinty of "Glee" and Celtic Thunder fame will appear as a special guest during the show.

At age 13, Bortnick is already an internationally renowned composer, pianist, singer and entertainer. He began composing music at age 5 and made history in 2011 as the youngest entertainer to headline a show in Las Vegas. In 2012 at age 9, he was certified by Guinness World Records as "The World's Youngest Solo Musician to Headline His Own Tour."

Also a young humanitarian, Bortnick has helped raise more than \$30 million for nonprofits around the world. Proceeds from his Pensacola show will help support station operations, public television programming and the educational services provided by WSRE.

Admission is \$50, and tickets can be purchased online at wsre.org. Previously, advance ticket orders were made available during WSRE's August on-air pledge drive.
