## **WSRE's StudioAmped Concert Series to Begin Airing April 3**

Pensacola, Fla. — Season 6 of StudioAmped, WSRE's popular concert series recorded in front of a live studio audience, will begin airing on WSRE April 3. Six concerts featuring regional bands performing original material were taped at WSRE's Jean & Paul Amos Performance Studio on the campus of Pensacola State College in February. The concert series highlighted a wide variety of musical genres.

This season of StudioAmped features pop, rock, funk, folk and blues, with artists Chris Alvarado of Santa Rosa Beach, Timberhawk of Pensacola, Flow Tribe of New Orleans, The Owsley Brothers of Santa Rosa Beach, New Earth Army of Destin and Fatty Waters of Pensacola performing.

All concerts were recorded in high-definition by WSRE's award-winning production team. Episodes will air on WSRE Thursdays at 9 p.m. beginning April 3, with a repeat on the following Wednesdays at 10 p.m.
