What you'll need:

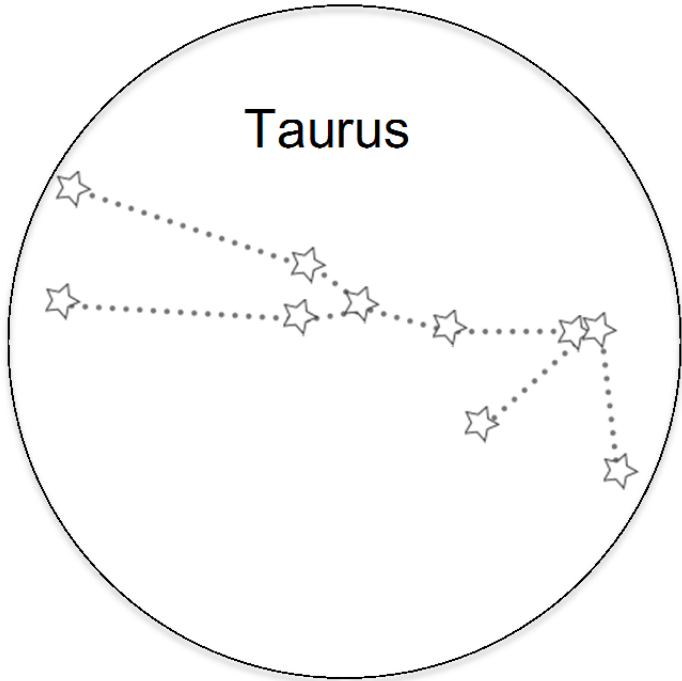
- Black construction paper
- Scissors
- Tape
- Constellation Templates
- Push Pins
- Construction Paper – Multi color
- Flash Lights
- Black Box
- Cutting Templates
- Stapler



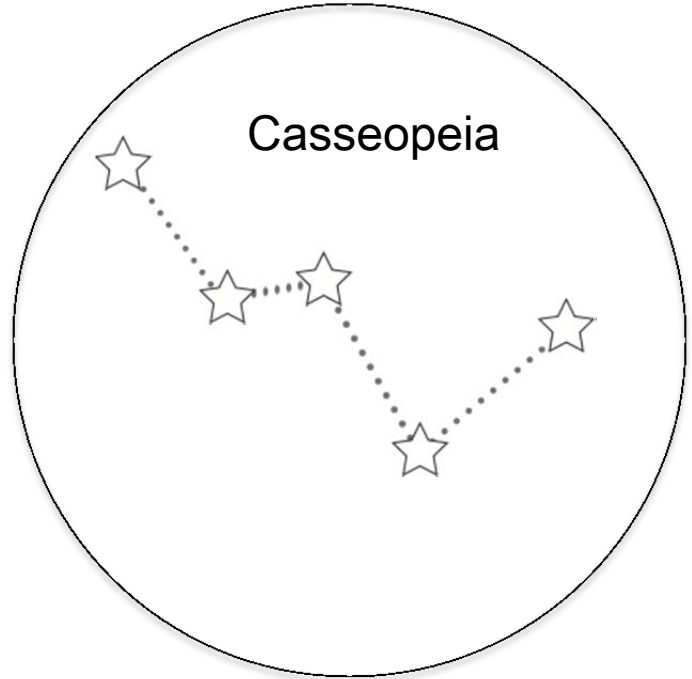
The Activity:

- Instruct children to choose a piece of construction paper. Roll it up and create a cylinder.
- Make sure the circle w/tabs will fit inside snugly.
- Cut holes in sides for tabs to fit through.
- Instruct children to cut out multiple circles with tabs.
- Demonstrate how to place the paper constellations over the circle w/tabs and use a push pin to create their own.
- Give each child a flashlight and allow them to try out their constellations in the black box. Experimenting with how they look close up and far away.
- To close (recover flashlights) encourage children to take home their planetarium to use at home while they try to find the constellations in the night sky!

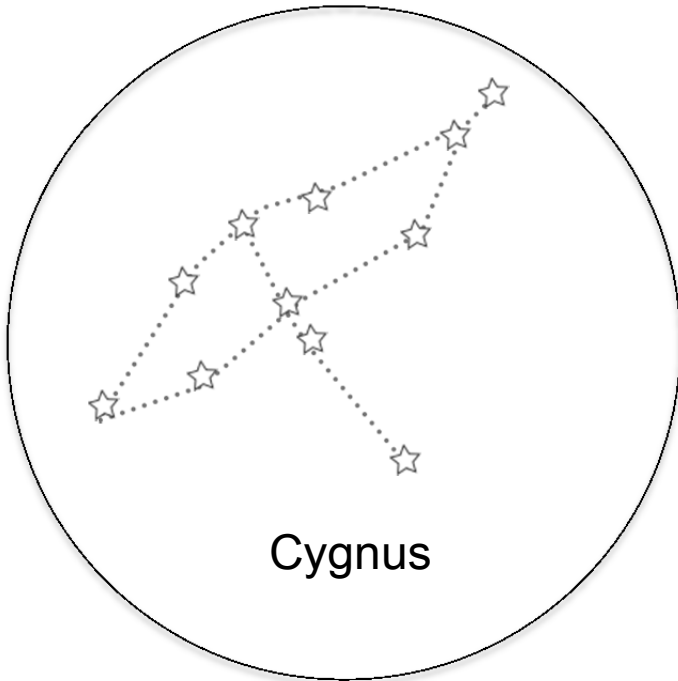
Taurus
